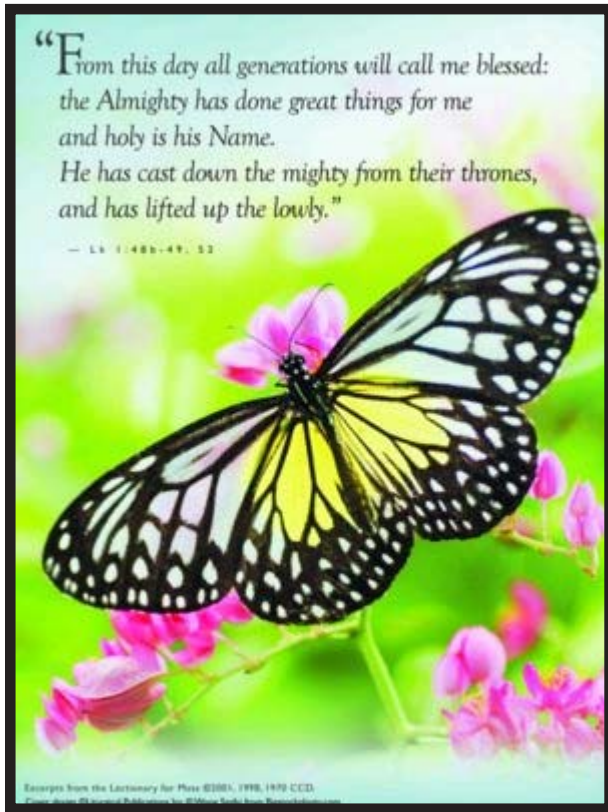

### WANT TO BE MORE COMPETENT AND CONFIDENT IN YOUR MINISTRY?

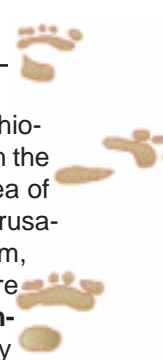

**WHAT IS IT?...WHO SHOULD ATTEND?... WHEN DO CLASSES BEGIN IN OUR PARISH?...WHO CAN I TALK TO IF I WANT MORE INFORMATION?**

OCIA stand for the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults within which are several "rites". The rite is a spiritual journey of three major stages:

1. PRECATECHUMENTE-People express an interest and a desire to become Catholic and to learn about the Church.
2. CATECHUMENATE-When grounded in the basic Catholic Christian teachings and experience a sense of repentance and desire to become a Catholic, they become catechumens. Their faith grows while being instructed and when receiving various rites. The completion of this stage is the Day of Election.
3. PERIOD OF PURIFICATION AND ENLIGHTENMENT-This stage is designated as "the election". The elect are chosen by God and are working toward the reception of the Sacraments.

With the satisfactory completion of their spiritual preparation, the candidate receives the three Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation and the Holy Eucharist. This takes place at the Easter Vigil.

Anyone who has questions about the Catholic faith can attend these free classes with no obligation or cost. Classes are open to anyone who has a desire to learn more about the faith. Catholics who have not received their First Communion or Confirmation may also attend.
